As you know, Mr. Eastwood is in no way a defendant, but someone that I have asked be informed along the way of the issues that I have attempted to have addressed that ultimately resulted in my arrest before your eyes on December 19th, 2003.

Since that time, I had a heart attack in the courtroom of Judge Adrienne Grover from the pressure of trying to clear my name. It would be hard for me to believe that a well informed man as yourself would not have heard about it, especially since it took place across the hall from the County Board of Supervisors' Meeting Room.

The complaint spells out the allegations against the various Monterey County agencies clearly, and I am requesting public comment, awareness and help from agencies of the United States that must exist to stop an American from being crushed by "Good Old Boys" gone mad when they have been cornered.

Currently, I am under a stay for medical recuperation from my open heart surgery but was forced to file this prior to the one year anniversary of my arrest.

I will attempt to attach the complaint and its two exhibits.

Even though it will not be for a few months, there is no doubt that it will be required in preparation of my case to take your deposition again. I promise you that it will be handled professionally as it was before, and I will make every effort to accommodate your schedule.

I will be putting this letter up on my website of AttorneyBusters.com. It is necessary as I step in front of the tanks of Monterey Good Old boys much like over in Tiananmen Square, China. It has been an incredibly difficult journey for my family and I, Tony.

Somebody has got to stand up and start helping me for the good of the entire community. Either way, I will continue until the matter is addressed.

As you know, I recently won an appeal. I am not an attorney but it certainly shows I am not a "vexatious litigant". I know the law, and anyone that does look at the case agrees the Good Old Boys lost their minds and somebody will ultimately go to jail over it.
