Dear Gentlemen,

It has now been weeks since you have been obstructing the criminal investigation of jury tampering by James Fincher and the Merced County Counsels office by not providing the report referenced above to the Merced County District Attorneys office according to normal law enforcement procedures.

Your report is far more than just a half ass job, i.e., you never spoke to James Fincher, you did not interweave my statements, or documents that I provided you that were provided to Grand Jury Foreperson Ellington and Grand Juror Tomsha which would reveal their statements to you to be a bunch of babbling lying horseshit, i.e., the package sent to them by a homeless Monterey person concerning the radio program that the grand juror Tomsha told me caused Fincher to advise the investigation had to be terminated due to my allegedly breaching the confidentiality of the grand jury (which they said to you they never talked about), you still cannot get around the fact that the Merced County Counsel spoke to them about terminating the investigation of themselves.
